An Apprenticeship is a brilliant first step on the career path in many businesses. They are an excellent way of gaining nationally recognised qualifications whilst earning a wage, and combine practical 'hands-on' experience with academic knowledge.

You can study

The level of Apprenticeship Standard you can apply for depends on what qualifications you have. You can progress from level 2 to level 7.

How much can you earn?

The National Minimum Wage for apprentices is £4.15 per hour, but many employers pay more.

What are the entry requirements?

Typically 4 GCSEs at Grade C/4 or above, including Maths and English, or a NVQ in a related subject, but each standard has different entry requirements so check with our Apprenticeships team.

What if you don't meet the entry criteria?

Don't worry, there are a number of routes you can follow to help you get the required skills to do an Apprenticeship. Please come in to the college to the Job Shop or call **01922 651129** and we can discuss your options.
